RE: IMPORTANT UPDATES AND INFORMATION REGARDING FREDERICK K.C. PRICE III CHRISTIAN SCHOOLS

Dear Frederick K.C. Price III Christian Schools Families,

I hope that all is well with you and your families. I would once again like to commend you for all your hard work, and for your partnership with FKCP III Christian Schools. I know that so many of you are balancing demands of work, family, and supporting the academic success of your children during this unprecedented pandemic. We thank you, because it takes our joint effort to accomplish the common goal of educating our students.

Governor Newsom's "Stay at Home" order and Mayor Garcetti's "Safer at Home" order, which was scheduled to end this Friday, May 15, remain in effect as of today, and it was announced yesterday evening that the order has been extended. The Los Angeles County Office of Education has not yet recommended that students return to their physical schools due to the ongoing pandemic. FKCP III Christian Schools do not expect to return to on-campus instruction this 2019-2020 school year; however, virtual instruction will continue. Our regularly scheduled Fall start date is late <u>August 2020</u>. We will keep you informed in the event of a change.

EDUCATING OUR STUDENTS IS VERY IMPORTANT TO THE FKCP STAFF. WE REMAIN COMMITTED TO OUR STUDENTS

Frederick K.C Price III Christian Schools is still providing regular virtual instruction to students with our teachers. This has proven to be beneficial and students can <u>ask questions in real-time</u>. In an effort to continue to support our students academically, we are planning to tentatively offer a summer school/summer enrichment program. If on-campus instruction is still not safe at that time, we are working on a plan to tentatively offer virtual instruction. Please know that we are also actively working on a plan that will include assessing our students learning and skill level, then developing academic success plans to address their needs. You will receive more information in the upcoming weeks.

SPECIAL EVENTS FOR FKCP STUDENTS

The social distancing guidelines and no large gathering mandates for safety, has prevented schools, including FKCP, from conducting school level trips, Grad Nite, and graduation/promotion ceremonies, in the same physical manner that we look forward to and have grown accustom to. Families of fifth, eight, and twelfth grade students will receive information and communication regarding our plans to recognize our students.
